4. 8. Section 4.4:

a. "The researchers discussed the potential implications of each variable based on empirical evidence and theories of



financial literacy." - Consider specifying what the researchers discussed for better clarity.

5. 9. Section 5 (Conclusion):

a. "So, MSMEs owners or managers, as well as government agencies, should pay attention to enhancing the positive financial attitude of MSMEs." - Consider rephrasing for better flow, e.g., "MSMEs owners or managers, along with government agencies, should focus on enhancing the positive financial attitude of MSMEs."

These are minor suggestions to enhance clarity and consistency. Overall, the article is well-structured and informative

Redaction improvements:

I highly recommend to re-read the whole text to correct said errors, it would be an impactful improvement.
