An implantable access device designed to provide repeated access to the peritoneal cavity for the delivery of medications and other fluids. Port access is performed by percutaneous needle insertion using a non-coring needle. The system consists of two primary components: an injection port with a self-sealing silicone septum and a radiopaque silicone rubber catheter.
