Specifically, it's not clear whether it's an article or short text notes. I suggest the authors i. outline the objectives of the article ii. relate the objectives to the intended research questions, iii. show clearly some hypotheses for the research, iv. expressively show the concepts that guide the study and possibly a framework to buttress the discussion of the paper.

v. relate the study and show the relevance of theories that underpin this research, highlighting their importance and relevance, situating this study in the context of today's reality

vi. relate that with some empirical evidence from extant literature on the title.

vii. There should be a clear methodology pathway for the literature reviewed; how it was done, the step-by-step process on how it was carried out, philosophy, sampling techniques, and justification for the research design, etc. These should be stated and incorporated into the work.

viii. There should be a clear section revealing what was discovered from the literature and also a clear discussion for positioning on the main title and as well what is in it for practice, and if possible, propose a model that will aid exploration of the opportunities.

Conclusively, the authors need to structure the paper after the pattern of a journal article format to show the different sections.
