1. The title needs modification: My recommendation is as follows:

"Studying the Level of Livelihood Vulnerability in the Coastal Area of Ben Tre: The Necessity of Developing a Farmhouse Economic Model to Adapt to Climate Change", mind that the word "Economic" was repeated in the title.

- 1. In the abstract part, it is good to include the data, methods, findings, and conclusions of your study. Reducing the introduction part in the abstract and inserting the above-mentioned elements facilitates easy communication with you and your audiences. Mind that the aim of abstracts is a short, overall introduction about the whole work. But from your work, it is impossible to understand all these without reading the whole paper.
- 2. In your "Ask a Problem" section, it is rather good to use "Statement of the Problem," which is a commonly used expression. And in this part, the author should include a comprehensive introduction about the scale of the problem and narrow down to the study area in question. This part can be extended and improved to make the article more relevant. And it is also advisable to clearly state why to carry out the research? What gaps are to be addressed in the study?
- 3. Research methods such as sampling techniques and methods of data analysis are not clearly stated. This really degrades the quality of your work, dear author. A community-based approach is not a research method! Otherwise, make it clear.
- 4. "Plant color" is not one of the "main livelihoods," or it is not clear.
- 5. The way vulnerability is measured is not clear. Was it indexed? How did you measure the performance of the economic models (farmhouse)?
- 6. The analytical approach can be improved.
- 7. Although the topic is indeed demanding to be done, the research approach can be improved so that your study can be used by the scientific community and contribute to the literature.
