- 1. The possible mechanism of action of *Fragaria ananassa* by which it is helpful to mitigate behavioral disturbances and oxidative stress.
- 2. The justification for using aripiprazole in comparison to the extract.
- 3. The name of the cerebrum and amygdala in the title and the description of these regions in the introduction is not relevant.
- 4. The procedure of extraction is not well-defined.
- 5. The overall manuscript needs an extensive literature search and explanations in all sections.
