The original research article titled A Study of “Motivational Variables as Predictors of Academic Achievement Among University Students” explores the motivational variables that may serve as predictors of academic achievement among university students. The authors succeeded in clearly emphasizing the strengths of their study. However, there are some gaps which could be bridged with a sufficient amount of argument and information so the ideas presented can be supported more thoroughly. The sample is limited to 17 students only, which seems inappropriate for the current study. Also, only non-random sampling was used, which actually limits the generalizability of results even more.
