The structure of the paper is established according to the trends in technical paper writing. The paper is organized sensibly and logically.

There are some comments:

- 1. Why did the author use "associated" instead of "correlated"? In statistical analysis, the correct notation is "correlated".
- 2. There are no references from 2021, 2022. Only one reference is from 2020. The author should discuss some recent publications (2020-2023).

I recommend the publication of the paper "Associations between direct contact with the oil and worsened health indicators after Deepwater Horizon oil spill: Results from Gulf States Population Survey" after minor revision.
