This manuscript is quite interesting, with an unusual topic in the academic world, with results that impact the studies with perception and participation/involvement of students by the environmental content. I have some suggestions for improvements in your research:

- Limitations only to the theme of participatory budget (PB). In future studies, please include other themes for verification and confirmation of your findings.
- I suggest the construction of an organogram to structure the feasibility of the applied methodology.
- It is necessary to include more recent works/manuscripts, exhaustively looking at other studies in the world related to your research.
- Statistical analyses are needed to check correlations, similarities and possible significant differences, highlighting on control and treatment groups, before and after activities/inquiries(pre and post-test questionnaires) through in an e-voting simulation, for example, and also including in other universities, as well as in secondary schools and other sectors of society. In other words, many possibilities can be useful for this captivating topic.
