The article is interesting and provides a lot of information about the fauna in the drawdown area. In any case, considering that the research has been based on the review of previous articles, it would be advisable to correct the errors in the bibliographic references and citations, which are too many. I have uploaded a text indicating all the corrections that are necessary.

On the other hand, I think that the author could include some type of bibliometric statistics, indicating the percentages of works that can be associated with each section of the article, since Figure 1 contains some indication in this regard, but it is insufficient considering the type of research. It would be good to have the percentages of studies that support the hypotheses and/or statements that can be found in the manuscript. Without this contribution, the reader is left with the feeling of having read a descriptive manual.
