Clarification is critical in the introduction, especially for security principles, and a more specific explanation of non-functional requirements is required for improved reader comprehension. The literature review is sufficiently in-depth and should be expanded by supporting literature relevant to development technology to strengthen the theoretical foundation. The lack of bibliographic references and up-to-date analysis poses a significant barrier, underlining the importance of including the most recent literature to substantiate and strengthen the research arguments.

Furthermore, the methodology used in data collection, particularly the interview strategy, should be thoroughly detailed to elucidate the chosen method successfully. To improve reader understanding, the description of the system architecture, hardware, and software requirements should be enhanced, and a more complete explanation of development tools is needed. Furthermore, checking generated web pages necessitates information addition and validity testing to assure the system's dependability and credibility. Finally, aligning research outcomes and objectives requires clarity, with more precise explanations needed to demonstrate the importance of results toward attaining the study's goals.
