Abstract:

- 1. Mention that 605 medical students from Khyber Pakhtunkhwa province answered the questionnaire. In fact, how many medical students (clinical and preclinical) are there in total in this region?
- 2. What is KPC?

Introduction:

- 1. The objectives are not well highlighted
- 2. I think that references should have been made to the results obtained from other countries, from other continents Material and methods
- 1. The study took place over a period of 6 months. But in the Discussions chapter you say that in the period June 2021-March 2022, which means 10 months
- 2. What are MBBS and BDS?
- 3. You state in the text that a questionnaire developed by them was used: by whom? Was it a validated questionnaire? How many questions did it have? It would have been good to be additionally attached to the text.
- 4. What are the inclusion and exclusion criteria in the study?
- 5. How did you analyze statistically? What was the working sample?

Discussions

It is a good study that would require comparing the results obtained with other studies from other countries.
