1.3 In-text citation "(Angoff & Barnhart, 2021; Garaigordobil & Larrain, 2020), (Martín-Criado et al., 2021), and (Martínez-Martínez et al., 2022)" does not appear in the references.

1.4 Recheck in-text citation "(Grahan & Wood, 2019)" or "Graham" in the reference.

1.5 Recheck in-text citation "Mickewright et al. (2015)" or "Micklewright" in the reference.

1.6 Recheck in-text citation "(Garcia et al., 2020)" or "González" in the reference.

1.7 Recheck in-text citation "Extremera & Fernández-Berrocal, 2005" or "2006" in the reference.
