

Review of: "Liver rheumatoid nodules imitating liver malignancy: a rare occurrence"

This case report nicely highlights the rarity of rheumatoid nodules in the liver and the diagnostic challenges one can face when suspected. In the end, the authors have nicely summarized the challenges, which involve the difficulty of diagnosing on imaging studies, the location of the nodule close to the diaphragm making it difficult to access, and the extensive investigation before and after the segmental liver resection. They ruled out other causes of the nodule, and the biopsy report also confirms a rheumatoid nodule. Overall, a very interesting and well-written case presentation with explanations.
