- 2. Consider changing the term from "Mental retardation" to "Intellectual disability".
- 3. To provide stronger evidence of the effect of Epilepsy surgery, please show in the demographic data in Table 1 the change in the dose and number of antiepileptic drugs before and after Epilepsy surgery.
- 4. P4 line 2: Please provide a reference to the Revised diagnostic criteria.
- 5. P4 line 10: Please provide a reference to the Eagel classification.
