- Introduction section is too long and can be more reconstructed.
- 49 of participants are nurses, I think it would be better if you included only the nurses. Three doctors will not make any difference.
- The article needs a serious language revision
- I could not identify any question in the questionnaire regarding the duration (in hours) of PPE
- Is there any relation between the duration period of PPE and skin reactions?
- The discussion is poor. The authors should provide the possible reasons of the adverse skin reactions at different anatomical sites.
