- 1. Address more recent data about hate incidents and crimes in the background section.
- 2. The validity and reliability of the survey instrument are better to be addressed.
- 3. The survey participants' percentages in table 1 are not correct.
- 4. Using the descriptive approach is sufficient and fulfills the objectives of the study. However, the overlapping between the characteristics in the subgroups may affect the results.
- 5. The data from the other university does not add to the research, especially for the small size of the sample, and could be excluded.
