

Review of: "Approaching to the Medicolegal Issues of Temporal Lobe Epilepsy: A Narrative Review"

Thank you for submitting the manuscript entitled 'Approaching to the Medicolegal Issues of Temporal Lobe Epilepsy: A Narrative Review'. This manuscript summarizes the legal and mortality complications in patients with temporal lobe epilepsy.

This is an interesting paper; however, there are several issues that should be addressed before this study can be published.

- The epilepsy type and seizure classification are not those recommended by the ILAE. Please update them.
- Antiepileptic drugs is not the most recent term recommended by the ILAE. You should use antiseizure medications.
- The introduction is too broad if the focus of this paper is cases of temporal lobe epilepsy.
- The review should have better organization of the topics discussed in the manuscript.
- In your review, you mentioned that all psychotic episodes are triggered by alcohol or drugs. This is not correct.
- A relevant section is missing in this manuscript: the ictal/interictal/peri-ictal psychosis. This must be included.
- A table summary with all the papers reviewed and for each section would be very helpful for the reader and would improve the quality of this paper.
- Finally, the information included in the conclusion section is not in the appropriate section, as some of the data included is presented for the first time.
