Phase Recurrence

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The return of a system of multiple oscillators to a general phase configuration identical to a recorded state. It is the result of the commensurability^[1] between the frequencies of its components, allowing for the exact replication of a collective state. This phenomenon, if it occurs, would functionally equate to temporal identity between the moments of said repetition.
