But the paper's title does not reflect the content of the paper.

The manuscript does not meet the requirements for a scientific paper. Some of my suggestions are:

The Abstract should be reformulated to include the aim of the study, methodology, the main results and conclusions.

The Introduction does not describe the objectives and results of the study; it is necessary to revise it to reflect the aim of the paper, the relevance of the research, the research questions.

I recommend including a Literature review section and to explain how this article is different from other studies.

The Conclusions are not complete and relevant. Because no hypotheses for later research are formulated, in the Conclusions part limitations and future research possibilities must be described.
