A rare, primary bone dysplasia characterized by proportional short stature, early cessation of bone growth, accelerated skeletal maturation, variable presence of earlyonset osteoarthritis and osteochondritis dissecans, and normal endocrine evaluation. The variable dysmorphic features include mild to relative macrocephaly, frontal bossing, midfacial hypoplasia, flat nasal bridge, brachydactyly, broad thumbs, and lordosis.
