

Review of: "A Survey Study on Women Entrepreneurship in the BTR Area of Assam"

The paper is not organised well. In the introduction, concept of women entrepreneurship needs to be introduced properly. Literature review is not well organised. No citation of literature is given in the literature review. No theoretical articles are covered in the literature review. It looks like a journalistic piece.

In Methodology, there is no justification why the author chose 50% of the population as sample. In a survey, the author can choose women entrepreneurs purposively however, within the women entrepreneurs he/she can choose randomly and if every strata within the women entrepreneurs is chosen then methodology would be stratified random sampling. So it should be a two-stage sampling method- in the first stage women entrepreneurs are chosen purposively and in the second stage, within the women entrepreneurs stratified random sampling should be adopted.

All findings are presented in bullet points. Author needs to write it properly and connect the findings with the existing literature. It is a simple objective survey, however based on the results, author recommends too many policy implications and subjective issues such as gender stereotypes, diversity etc. And most of the recommendations are not based on the actual findings.

The author needs to read a lot of literature on women entrepreneurship and add to the review.

Overall, it is not suitable for publication.
