

Review of: "Psychosocial Rehabilitation Services for Persons with Substance Use Disorder"

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Potential competing interests: No potential competing interests to declare.

The article is clear in its writing and offers the reader an overview of the services offered to care for people with substance use problems. However, I believe that this can be improved if the following changes are made:

- 1) The introduction can be improved if it begins by addressing substance use globally and then specifically in the country where the care center that is intended to be described is located; what motivated the creation and opening of the center; and finally, the objective of the article. This is already included in the center's evolution section, but as it is written, what is described in the introduction is confusing.
- 2) Clarify why it is relevant to make the chapter to describe what is done in this center.
- 3) What is meant by psychosocial rehabilitation and what a center is supposed to offer to fulfill this.
- 4) I think that in the end, it should be discussed whether the center meets what is expected of a place that offers psychosocial rehabilitation.
- 5) Cite in the text the tables that are included at the end; it is not clear why they are presented.
- 6) There are some segments where some data about the services offered are described. If they are available for everyone, I suggest always doing so.
