- 1. The abstract needs to be more focused on the objectives and relevant outcomes.
- 2. Overall, there are language issues which need to be corrected.
- 3. The introduction is too long, and not focused to the matter of interest.
- 4. The authors should provide how many TSC cases with refractory epilepsy were screened for surgical candidacy in the study period
- 5. The baseline characteristics should provide more neurophysiological data- ictal onset, bilateral ictal and inter-ictal findings etc.
- 6. Did any patient undergo invasive EEG monitoring?
- 7. The authors should comment on selection criteria for achieving good surgical outcomes
