

Review of: "Biliary Complications Following Liver Transplantation: The First Single-Center Tunisian Experience"

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In this paper, the authors describe their experience with biliary complications following liver transplantation. Unfortunately, the layout of the article is very hard to follow, specifically in the patient characteristics portion. It is very hard to know if the authors are describing only those patients who had biliary complications or if they are referring to all patients. Additionally, including patients who underwent both a deceased donor and a living donor in the same cohort does not seem like a fair comparison, as these two approaches have very different surgical outcomes. To the same point, when they discuss the cold and warm times, is this for the entire cohort or just deceased donors? When the authors mention that their patients underwent biliary drainage, they need to clarify if this was internal or external drainage.
