Rural toilet retrofitting is an important part of improving China's rural human settlements. This project is of great significance to the health of Chinese rural residents. However, as mentioned by the author, there are many problems in the implementation of this project. Therefore, it is very necessary to explain these problems by studying the influence mechanism. I agree with the author's conclusion. However, it may be limited to the difficulty of data acquisition and geographical familiarity. The author takes Jiaozhou City, Shandong Province as the research area. The development of Jiaozhou is at a good level in China. Therefore, I am more concerned about the western rural areas with relatively implemented development level. Will the impact mechanism in the process of toilet transformation in those areas be the same as that in Jiaozhou City?
