Thank you for the opportunity to review this manuscript. The contribution is suitable for publication; I'm just making some suggestions for your better understanding.

1. "If this theory holds, clams would be preferred due to their higher energy content and profitability, even though handling times among the **three prey species** are similar." This sentence is somewhat confusing. Does it refer to the two species studied in this manuscript (then there should be 2 species) or to the three species studied in the work by Savini D and Occhipinti A (2006)?
2. Could you suggest specific details about the tank substrate that should be included?
3. Indicate that the prey are native species of the Río de la Plata and whether they are subject to commercial fisheries.
