The author needs to reveal the strata and the proportion used for selecting the sample size of 374 postgraduate students of the private universities in Selangor, Malaysia.

Discussion

The author needs to understand that the purpose of the study deals with relationship and not influence as shown in the Discussion that "The study investigated the influence of instructor immediacy behavior on course satisfaction in an online learning setting.

It is better to use mediation instead of Impact and effect. This impact - (this can be removed), however, is partially mediated by perceived learning. The findings support this mediation effect - (this can be removed), which is consistent with the hypothesis. Possible explanations for this include the idea that effective- (this can be removed) immediate behaviors improve students' perceptions of learning and course satisfaction.

The statement that "the finding indicated that recognizing and confirming students' personal and professional obligations; providing timely and accurate information while using rich media" was inferred. It was not part of the findings. Finally, the author will have to consider the use of words:
