Abstract

An abstract should state or provide (1) the purpose or principal aims and scope of the study, (2) a description of the method or approach employed, (3) a summary of core findings, and (4) the main conclusions of the study. These components of an abstract are not apparent in this article.

The introduction should include the aims of the research and why it is important and to whom, i.e., the major contribution of the paper. The focus of this article is clearly stated. The other items are not apparent.

Project themes are well described. However, tabulating these themes could enhance the presentation, and perhaps the understanding of these themes. For example, the table could contain the following columns: No., Project theme, Theme description, and Related human rights. This table can be populated with all 21 project themes.

Undesirable consequences are well discussed, and mitigating actions are clearly stated.
