We know that some diseases such as Crohn's, hereditary angioedema lead to a picture mimicking acute abdomen. I think it would be good to add pathophysiology to the manuscript. Such a sentence can be added " Edema of the intestinal mucosa can lead to transient obstruction and severe abdominal pain that can mimic acute abdomen".
